 245 Tache Crescent – R1Z Zoning District
 Virginia Demchuk

Grounds and Issues:

THE APPELLANT, Virginia Demchuk has filed an appeal under Section 219(1)(b) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* in connection with the refusal to issue Development Permit for an attached deck, for the property located at 245 Tache Crescent.

The property is zoned R1A under Zoning Bylaw 8770.

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Section 5.8(4)(b) states that a raised patio or deck measuring more than 0.6 metres (1.969 feet) height above grade can project no more than 25% of the width of the required side yard 0.75 metres (2.461 feet).

Based on the information provided the proposed deck is 0 metres from the property line. This results in a deficiency of 0.562 metres (1.844 feet).

The Appellant is seeking the Board's approval for the Development Permit as submitted.
