1. APPEAL NO. 4-2017 Refusal to Issue Development Permit Proposed Freestanding Sign - Sign Group 4 (Exceeding Maximum Allowable Size 3331 – 8th Street East – B4 Zoning District Priority Permits

The Board Chair briefly outlined the procedures that would be followed during the course of the hearing and introduced the members of the Board, the Secretary and the City's representative.

Grounds and Issues:

THE APPELLANT, Priority Permits Ltd. has filed an appeal under Section 219(1)(b) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* in connection with the refusal to issue a Freestanding Sign – Sign Group 4 at 100 3331 8th Street East.

The property is zoned B4 under Zoning Bylaw 8770.

Section 3.4.3.1(3) of Appendix A, of the Zoning Bylaw states the size of any single sign face area on a primary freestanding sign must not exceed 19.0m² in size.

Based on the information provided the dimensions of the freestanding sign would be approximately 23.37 m². As a result the proposed dimensions do not meet the required size regulations for freestanding signs in this district.

The Appellant was seeking the Board's approval for the Sign Permit as submitted.
