 Order to Remedy Contravention
 Fence Height
 (Front Yard Fence Exceeding Maximum Allowable Height)
 2901/2903 Arlington Avenue – R2 Zoning District
 Wallace Heroux

PRELIMINARY ISSUES:

Business Licensing & Bylaw Compliance Manager Richter requested to submit into evidence a photo showing the carport that was removed. The Appellants agreed to

allow the submission and the Board concurred. The document was entered into the record as Exhibit R.3.

Grounds and Issues:

THE APPELLANT, Wallace Heroux has filed an appeal under Section 219(1)(c) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, in connection with an Order to Remedy Contravention dated February 27, 2017 for the property located at 2901/2903 Arlington Avenue.

The Order to Remedy Contravention was issued for this property on February 27, 2017 pursuant to Section 242(4) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007,* and the Order states as follows:

"Contravention"

- The property at 2901/2903 Arlington Avenue is located in R2 zoning district. In an R2 zoning district no wall, fence, or other structure not otherwise permitted shall be erected in a required front yard, or on a site line adjacent to a required front yard, to a height of more than 1.0 metres above grade level.
- 2. A fence has been erected in the required front yard of this site 2901/2903 Arlington Avenue, to a height of more than 1.0 metres above grade level which is not permitted.

You are hereby ordered to:

 On or before April 15, 2017, reduce the height of the fence located in the required front yard of this site 2901/2903 Arlington Avenue to a height of not more than 1.0 metres above grade level.
