A1) Proposed Bylaw No. 7411 to amend Electrical Rates Bylaw No. 2685 Increase in Rates (File No. CC 1905-3)

Report of the Manager, Electrical Distribution Department, March 29, 1994:

"The proposed Bylaw No. 7411, a bylaw to amend the electric rates charged by the City of Saskatoon, has been prepared for consideration by City Council. The rate changes covered by this bylaw would result in an average rate increase of 3.8% and would be applicable to all electrical use on and after April 1, 1994.

The proposed rate changes are in response to an increase in the cost of bulk electricity supply from the Saskatchewan Power Corporation. On April 1, 1994, the City will pay an additional 3.8% on all bulk power purchased from the provincial power grid. The increase in the bulk power rates charged to the City is coincident with rate increases announced by SaskPower for all its retail customers throughout the Province, including its surrounding Saskatoon service area. SaskPower had previously indicated that small annual rate increases would be necessary over a three to four-year period commencing in 1992.

The most recent electrical rate increase by the City took place in January 1993. Under the currently proposed rate changes, the average monthly bill for a residential consumer will rise by about \$1.70, while the average monthly bill for a small commercial customer in General Service II (up to 15 kVA load) will rise by about \$5.00. Some minor adjustments are being made to the rates for Cityowned street lighting to more closely reflect the cost of service for individual fixture types. In addition, City-owned and maintained Dust to Dawn Flood Lighting and Highway Street Lighting will be charged the same rates as street lighting."

RECOMMENDATION: that City Council consider proposed Bylaw No. 7411 at this meeting.
