City Council, at its meeting held on June 28, 1999, resolved that the term of the South Downtown Revitalization Agreement made between the City and Princeton Developments Ltd. be extended to April 30, 2000, upon the following conditions:

- a) that on or before July 15, 1999, Princeton submit a preliminary concept plan to the Development Services Branch of Community Services detailing the proposed re-development of the South Downtown;
- b) that on or before September 15, 1999, Princeton submit to the City a letter of committal from a major anchor tenant, in a form acceptable to the City Solicitor, acting reasonably, committing such tenant to the proposed redevelopment;
- c) that Princeton perform each and every of the terms and conditions set forth in the South Downtown Revitalization Agreement in accordance with the tenor thereof, together with all such further terms and conditions as attached to the November 10, 1998, extension of such Agreement; and
- d) that failure to observe or perform any of the noted conditions shall result in the immediate termination of the South Downtown Revitalization Agreement.

With respect to recommendation (b), your Committee has met with representatives of Princeton Developments Ltd. and been advised that negotiations with proposed major anchor tenants, while positive, are not capable of final resolution prior to September 15, 1999. Negotiations are expected to conclude very shortly after such date. Accordingly, the Committee has concluded that it would be in the best interests of the City to amend the date for the submission of the required "letter of committal" to October 29, 1999."
