

BYLAW NO. 1580

A Bylaw to prohibit bathing in the South Saskatchewan River within the limits of the City of Saskatoon.

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts as follows:

1. No person shall bathe in the South Saskatchewan River situated within the limits of the said City.
2. Bylaw No. 1277 is hereby repealed.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.

Read a first time this 8th day of June 1925.

Read a second time this 8th day of June 1925.

Read a third time and passed this 8th day of June 1925.
