

**1. What is the current condition of Mayfair Pool?**

Mayfair Pool was opened in July 1959 and has now reached the expected life for this type of facility. The City of Saskatoon hired Cochrane Engineering to examine the condition of the pool, including the structure of the pool basin and deck, and various mechanical and piping systems. The condition assessment recommended extensive repair, both structural and mechanical.

**2. Can Mayfair Pool be repaired?**

The upgrades that would be required for Mayfair Pool are so major that the entire pool would need to be rebuilt.

**3. Why hasn't the City kept up with the repairs?**

All City of Saskatoon facilities, including Mayfair Pool, are managed under an ongoing preventive, maintenance program to ensure all components are maintained to the appropriate standards. Eventually, however, facilities do wear out. Mayfair Pool has reached the point where repairs are so extensive that it will need to be entirely rebuilt.

**4. How large is the new Mayfair Pool compared to others in the City?**

The new Mayfair Pool will have a pool bather load of approximately 400 people. Riversdale's bather load is 750, George ward, 650 and Lathey, 300.

**5. Will there be a seasonal multi-purpose room in this new facility?**

Yes, the Mayfair Pool building structure will include an insulated multi-purpose room that can be used during the pool's off-season.

**6. How much will it cost to replace Mayfair Pool?**

Currently City Council has approved \$750,000 for the detailed design of Mayfair Pool and \$4,250,000 for the construction of Mayfair Pool.

**7. When will Mayfair Pool be built?**

It is anticipated that Mayfair Pool will begin construction in the spring of 2011, and construction will be complete in the spring of 2012.

**8. When will Mayfair Pool re-open to the public?**

It is anticipated that Mayfair Pool will re-open to the public in the summer of 2012.

**9. What is the next step in the development of Mayfair Pool?**

Following the public engagement process, the Administration will finalize the design and will report to City Council, requesting the approval of the Mayfair Pool detail design. It is anticipated this report will go forward to City Council by December 2010. The Administration plans to tender this project by March 2010.
