

Fire Pits/Barbeques

Open fires are NOT allowed in parks or Kinsmen Park Picnic Shelter. Fire pits in parks are on a first-come, first-serve basis (not located in all parks). Users must supply their own fire wood. Propane barbeques are allowed in parks/shelter.

Picnic Shelters/Tables

Picnic tables are situated throughout Neighborhood, District, Multi-District, and Special Use Parks. Additional picnic tables for park bookings are not available.

Kinsmen Park Picnic Shelter, located in Kinsmen Park (City Park) (Special Use), Spadina Crescent & 25th Street - Contact Customer Services 975-3366 Fax 975-2954 (Lawson Civic Centre) for applications. Kinsmen Park Picnic Shelter is available May 1 to September 15.

Permit will allow access to Shelter, but not surrounding park area. Other activities may be occurring. If you have booked the Shelter with Kinsmen Park Ride Package, permit will be issued with ride contract.

Facility is no charge. A \$10 cash or cheque deposit is required until key is returned. Key can be picked up at Lawson Civic Centre, 225 Primrose Drive on the day of your rental. Do not leave valuables in Shelter as other groups may have keys.

Cold water tap outside building, electrical lights inside, 1 small electric plug-in inside and 1 on external wall by door, 1 table in shelter, propane BBQ can be used, washrooms available (open to public)

It is rental group's responsible to ensure area has been left in a clean fashion.

Washrooms

Open to the Public May to September 1, 10 am - 10 pm (by Commissionaires).

If your event has been approved, and you require access before 10 am, a key can be picked up at Lawson Civic Centre, 225 Primrose Drive on the day of your event. A \$10 cash or cheque deposit is required until key is returned.

If you will be erecting temporary washrooms, contact Parks Liaison, 975-3126 once your permit is issued.
