PRIMARY TRAILS

Holiday Park Golf Course

Access at Avenue U South

Outside loop 3.5 km double tracked & skating track.

Wildwood Golf Course (maintained by the Saskatoon Nordic Ski Club) Access at 8th Street East

A 2.5 km and 10 km trail set for classic skiing and a 5.5 km trail set for both classic and skate skiing.

Kinsmen Park (maintained by the Saskatoon Nordic Ski Club) Access at Spadina Cres. West by the Mendel Art Gallery. 2 km single tracked & lighted skating track.

Lower Meewasin Park

Access at Pinehouse & Whiteswan Drives.

Loop 4.8 km single tracked.

Upper Meewasin Park

Access at Pinehouse and Whiteswan Drives

Loop 3.4 km single tracked.

Meewasin Park to Adilman buffer

Access at eastend of Adilman Drive or Meewasin Park

2 km single tracked.

Access at Ruth Street & St. Henry Avenue

2.6 km single tracked.

Forest Park

Access at Lowe Rd, Nelson Rd & Forest Dr. 2 km single tracked. Connecting link to Silverspring Park.

SPEEDSKATING

Clarence Downey Speedskating Oval

11th Street & Avenue R South in Gordon Howe Complex

The Clarence Downey Speedskating Oval offers an exciting change of pace for skating enthusiasts! No need for speed skates to enjoy a day on this 400 metre oval - there are different lanes for different speeds and lots of room for every level of skater. A modern warmup building lets you lace up your skates in comfort. There is also vending machines, change rooms and public washrooms. Admission is FREE.
