

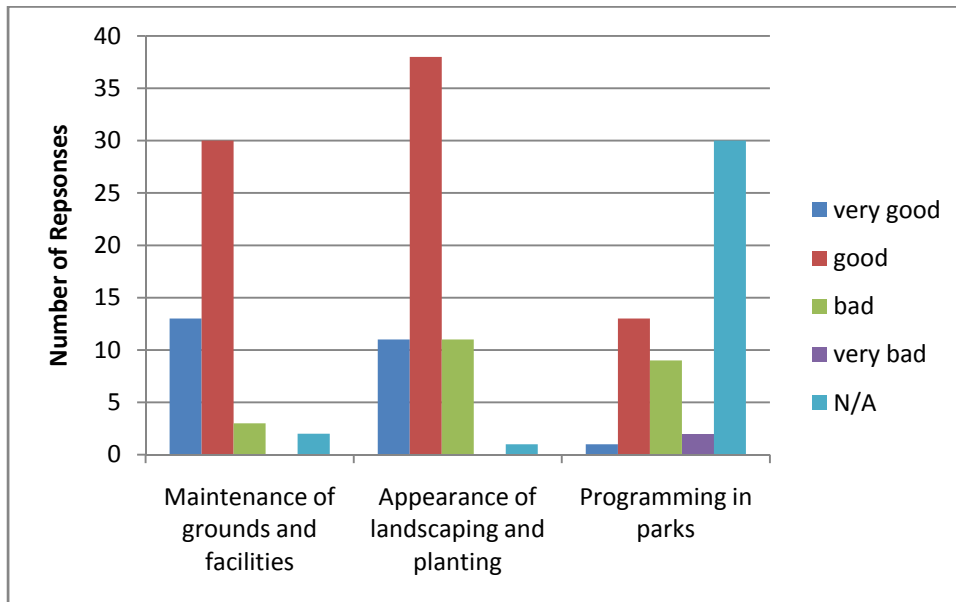

(total number of responses = 65)



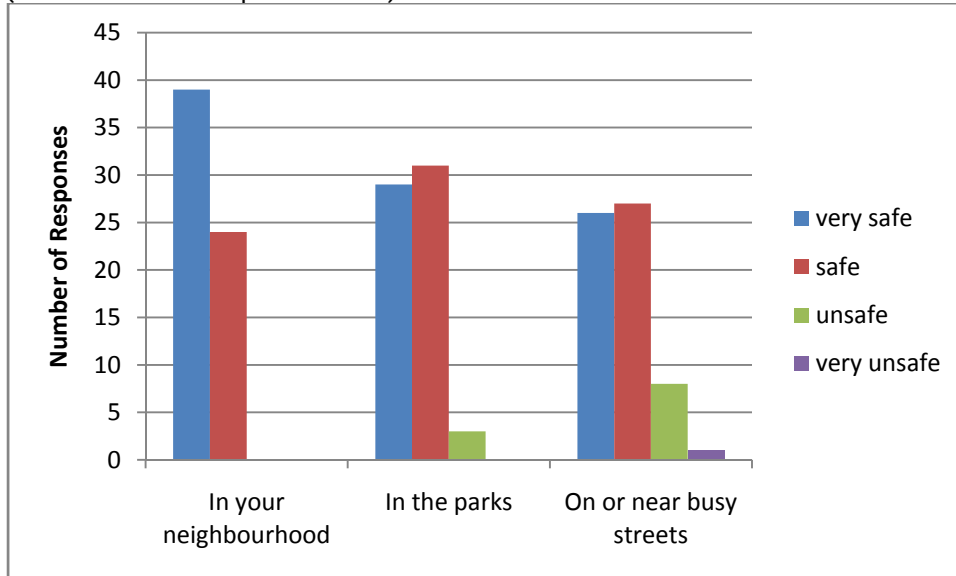
Comments:

- More garbage bins in President Murray Park

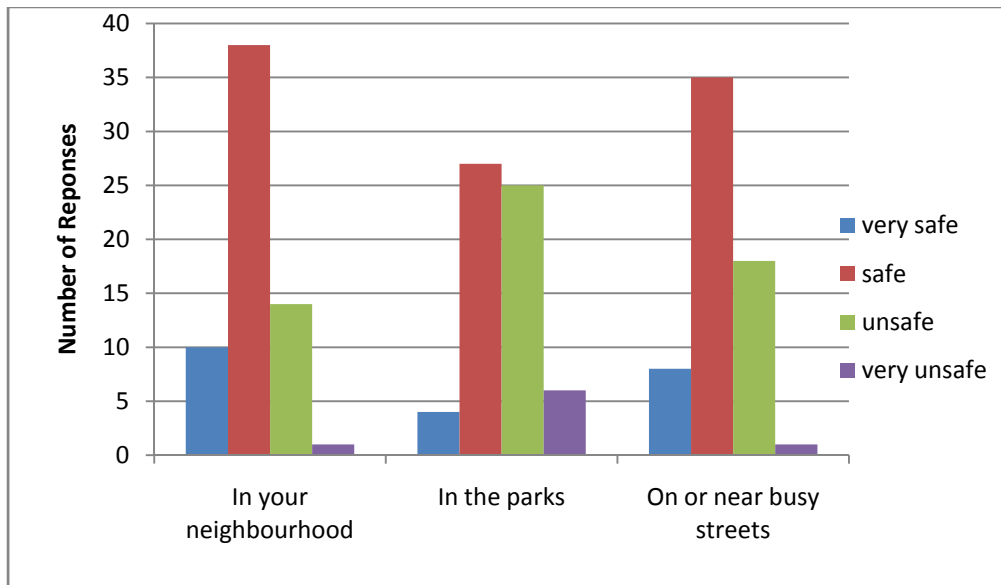

(total number of responses = 63)



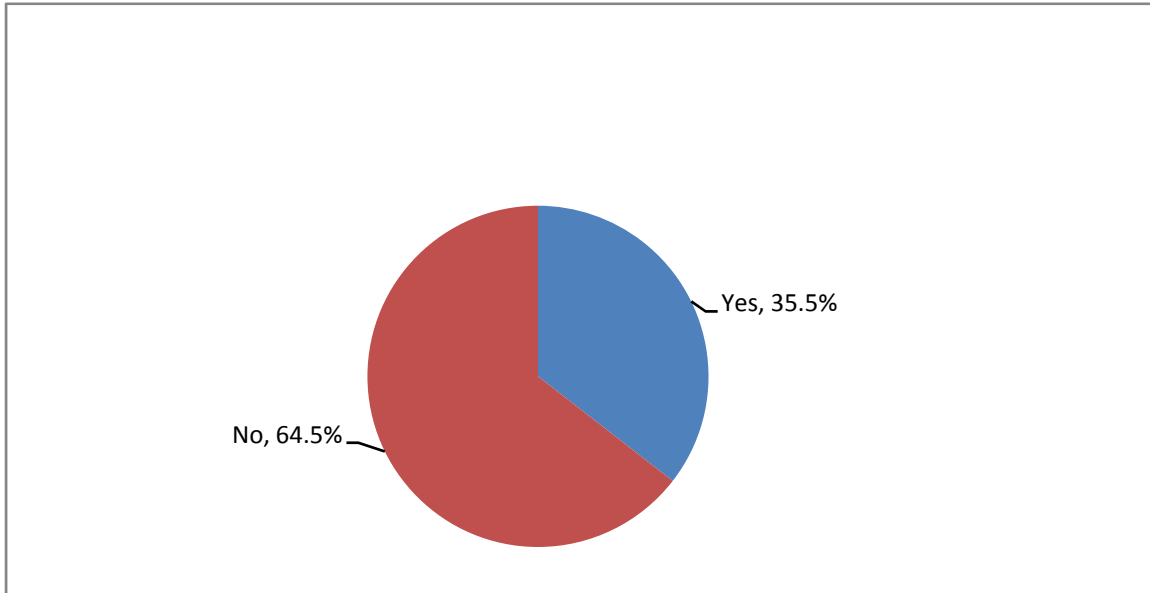

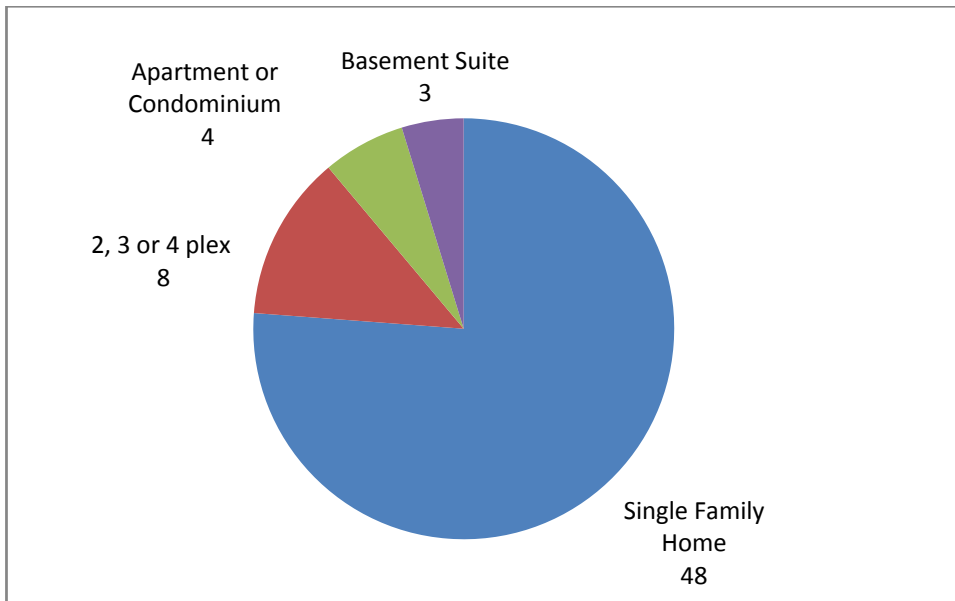

What kind of dwelling do you live in?

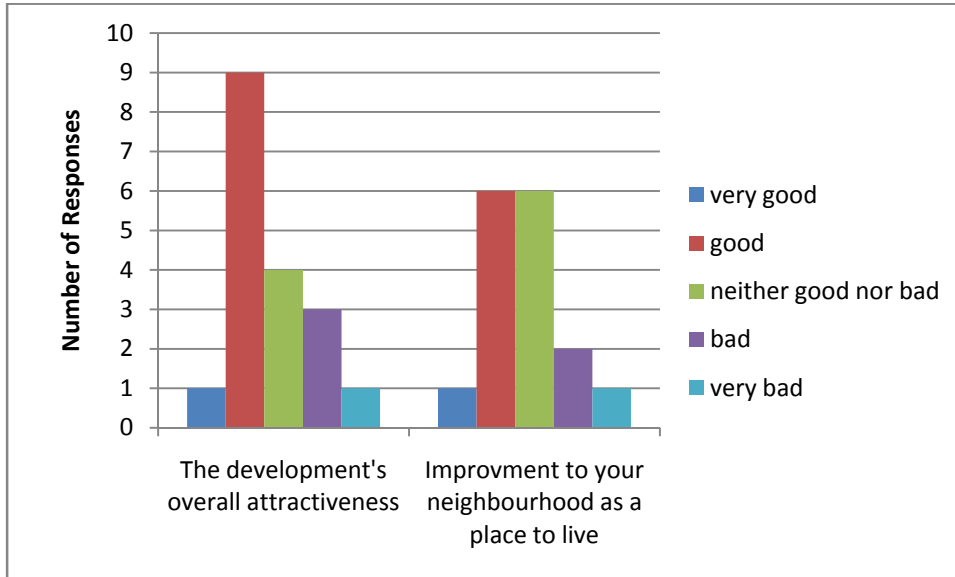

(total number of responses = 62)

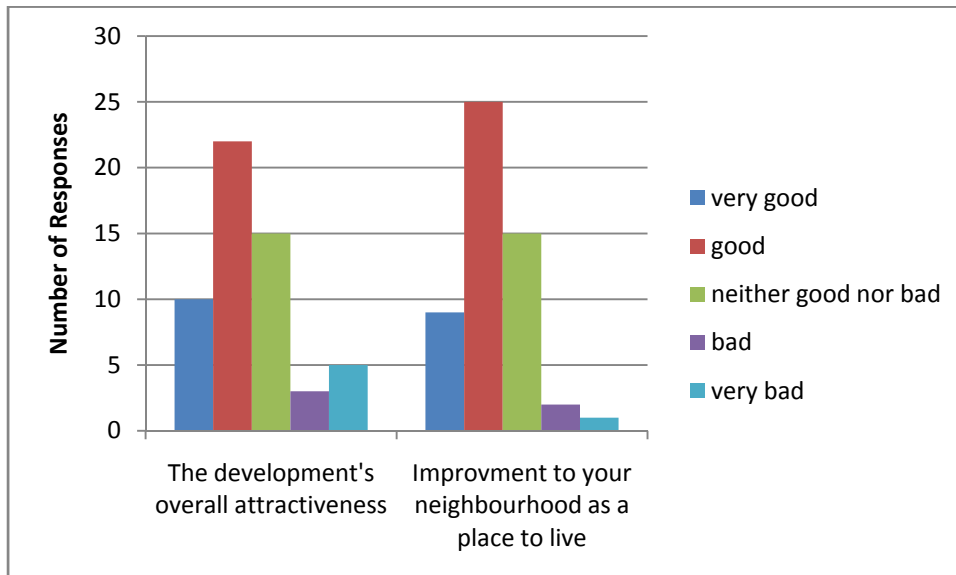

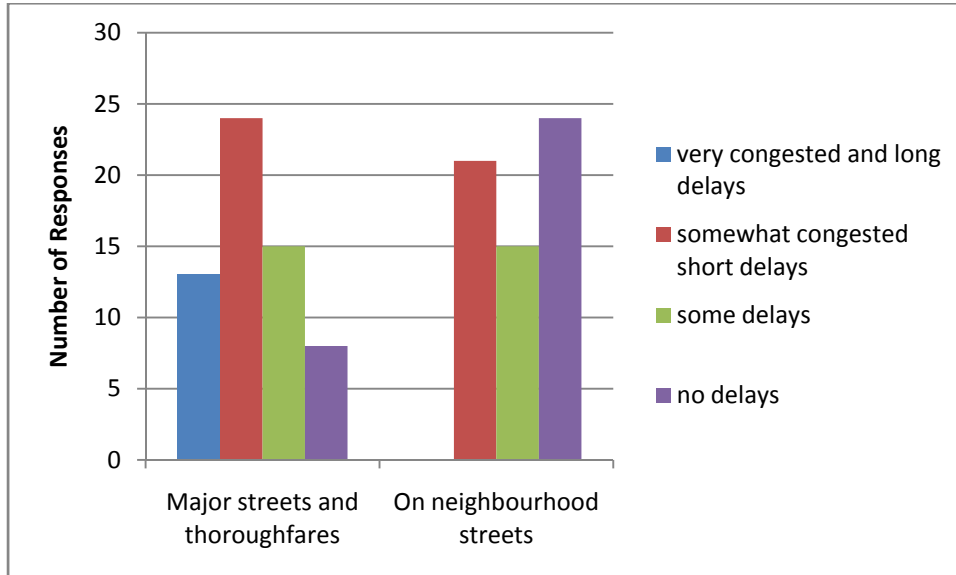

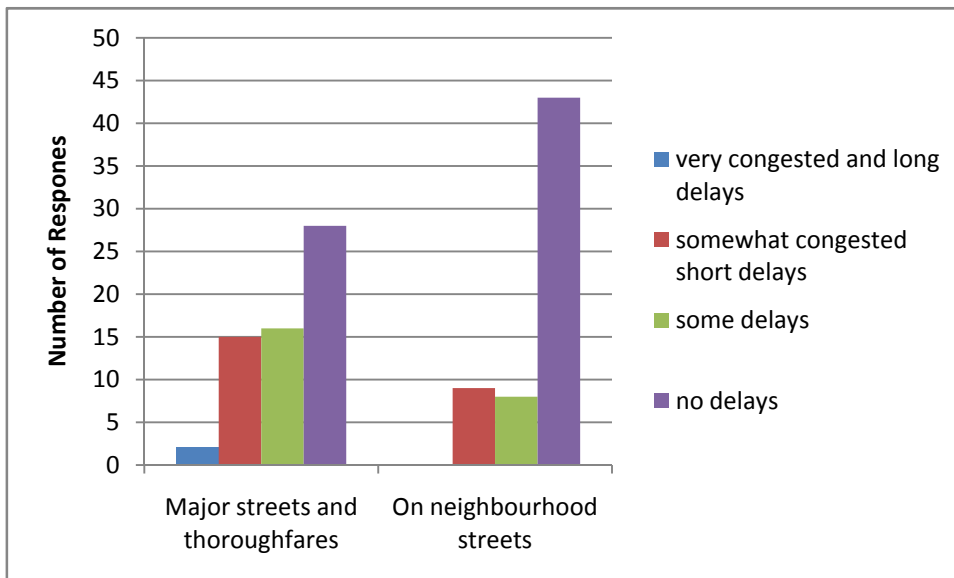
How would you rate the traffic flow in Varsity View **during both the morning and evening “rush hours”** on:

(total number of responses = 60)



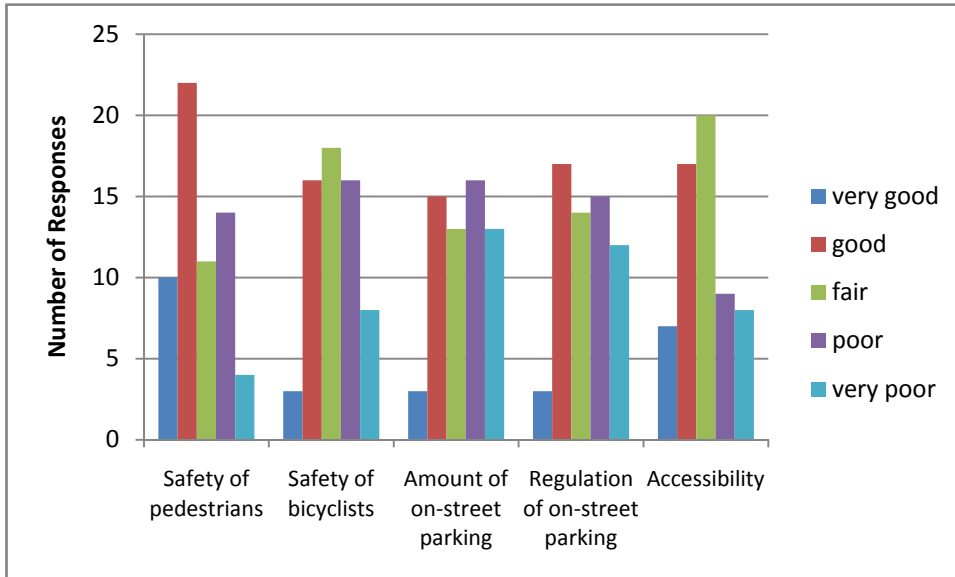
How would you rate the traffic flow in Varsity View **during non-peak hours** on:

(total number of responses = 61)



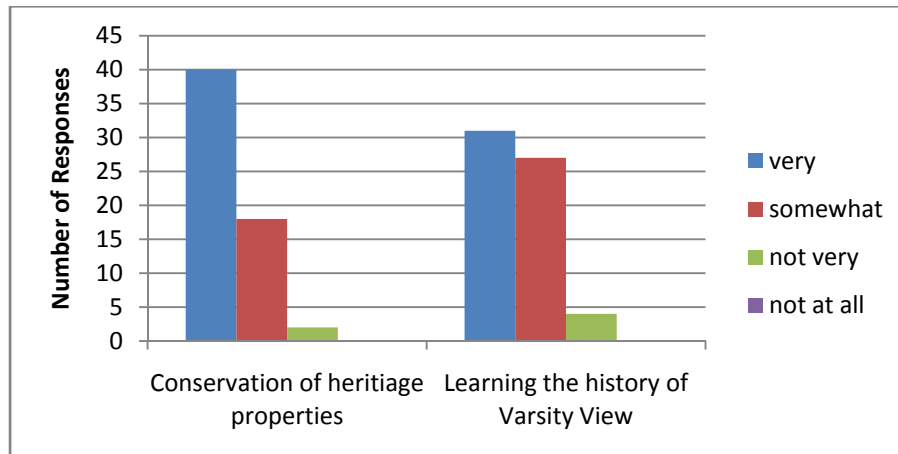

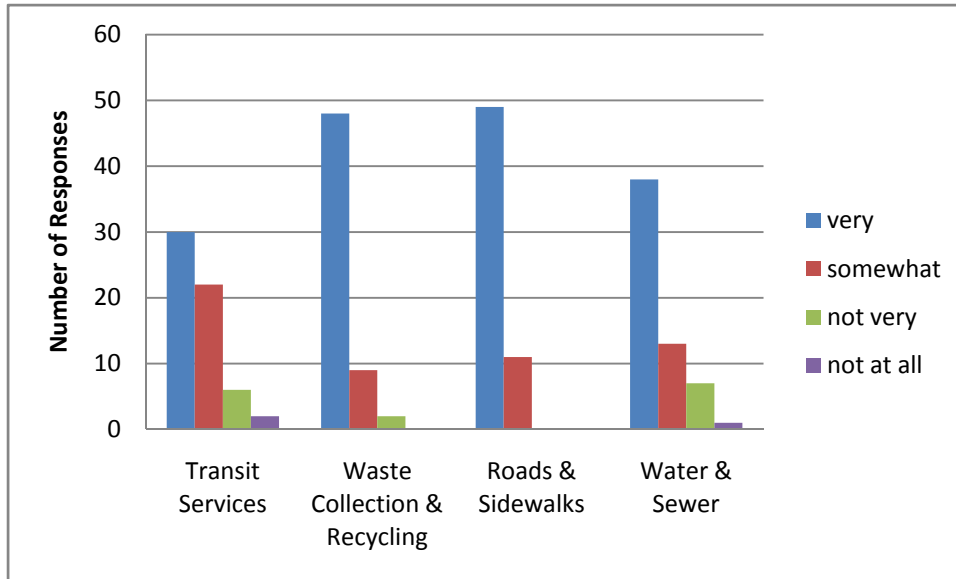
How important are the..
