The Planning Education Program

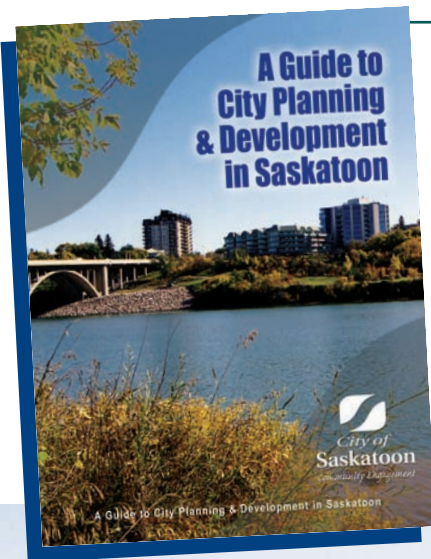
