

Keep Signs Off

Signs are prohibited on the following streets and their adjacent boulevards:

- 11th Street between Chappell Drive and the western limit of the city
- Airport Drive
- Circle Drive (except between Warman Road and the CNR spur line west of Avenue C)
- College Drive east of Cumberland Avenue
- Highways 7 & 14 between Diefenbaker Drive and the western limit of the city
- Idylwyld Drive (except between 20th Street and the CNR overpass north of 39th Street)
- Interchange at the south junction of Highways 11 & 16
- Attridge Drive between Circle Drive and McOrmond Drive
- Wanuskewin Road between 51st Street and the northern limit of the city
- Warman Road between 33rd Street and 51st Street
- McOrmond Drive between Attridge Drive and Highway 5
- 22nd Street between Witney Avenue and Diefenbaker Drive
- Spadina Crescent
- Whiteswan Drive
- Saskatchewan Crescent

Important information about Garage Sale, Yard Sale, & Real Estate Open House Signs

Illegal signs will be REMOVED**

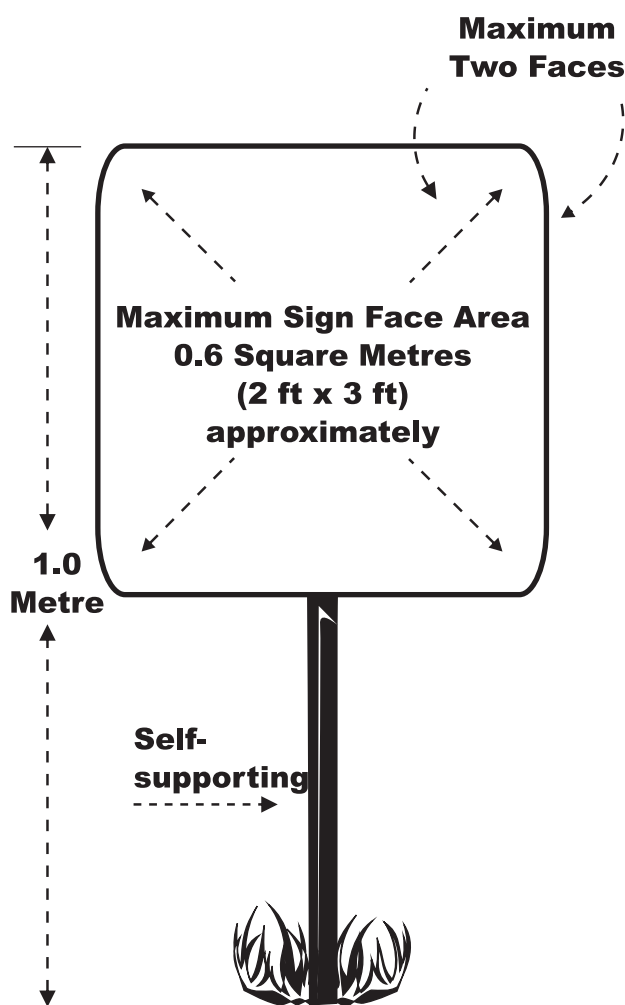

If you are erecting temporary signs for a garage sale or open house, make sure you observe the Temporary Sign Bylaw; otherwise you could face a fine.

ILLEGAL SIGNS WILL BE REMOVED

Design



Design

Your sign must be constructed to meet these requirements:

- Sign face area of 0.6 square metres or less (approximately two feet x three feet)
- No more than two sign faces
- Must be self-supporting (cannot be attached to any city property such as fences, street light poles, traffic signal poles, etc.)
- Top must be less than 1.0 metre above ground level or approximately three feet.

Incorrect Signs

The following signs are prohibited:

- Balloon signs or other inflatable devices, electronic message centers or kites.
- Temporary signs that resemble any traffic control device.
- Portable signs.
- Signs on any center median, traffic island, or sidewalk.
- Signs must not create a potential hazard to vehicular or pedestrian traffic.

Placement of Signs

Signs meeting the design requirements are permitted on City right-of-way provided they are placed to meet the following SETBACK REQUIREMENTS.

Your sign must be a MINIMUM of:

- 2.0 metres or six feet from the curb (or 6.0 metres from the nearest driving lane, if no curb exists)
- 1.0 metre or three feet from any City sidewalk or pathway.
- 2.0 metres or six feet from any fire hydrant.



Garage & Yard sale signs may be

put up at the beginning of the sale, and **MUST BE REMOVED** immediately following the sale.



Open house signs may only be displayed while the open house is in progress.
