




# Coordinated Community Safety Plan Highlights

## 325 Avenue C – Women’s Warming Centre

The Coordinated Community Safety Plan outlines the City of Saskatoon’s safety and security support for the Government of Saskatchewan’s service provider, Saskatoon Tribal Council, while it operates a Women’s Warming Centre at 325 Avenue C.

Safety personnel will support the facility staff and participants, as well as members of the community and public. Safety personnel will provide regular wellness checks, connect people with supports where possible, de-escalate situations, and when required, contact the Saskatoon Police Service regular patrol for additional support.

<p><b>Coordinated and enhanced presence of Public Safety Personnel</b></p> 	<p>An ongoing randomized presence will be available in the immediate surrounding and nearby areas to assist with any transitional concerns such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social disorder</li> <li>• Public Safety (pedestrian paths, alleys, parks and green spaces)</li> <li>• Violence and weapons</li> <li>• Identification of temporary, unsafe and inadequate structures in green spaces, parks and thoroughfares</li> </ul> <p>Public safety personnel include:</p> <p><b>Saskatoon Fire Department - 24 hours a day</b> Uniformed Fire Inspectors, Fire Bylaw Inspectors and Fire Community Support personnel will provide both a regular focused patrol and a random patrol response throughout a 24-hour cycle. They will attend to the Women’s Warming Centre and surrounding area to observe, address situations posing a risk where practical, engage in conversation, and offer supports in addition to site and area inspections. Frontline Fire emergency personnel will respond to emergency calls, 24 hours a day.</p> <p><b>Saskatoon Police Service - 24 hours a day</b> Alternative Response Officers (ARO’s), Community Mobilization Unit (CMU’s), Bike Unit Officers (operating in vehicles during the winter months) and Uniformed Patrol Officers will attend to the shelter and surrounding neighbourhood area in a marked vehicle and conduct conversation and visual inspection of the area. They will provide both a regular focused patrol and a random patrol response throughout a 24-hour cycle. Patrol officers will respond to emergency calls, 24 hours a day.</p> <p><b>Commissionaires - 7-day-per-week, extended-hour security</b> Commissionaires will provide 7-day-per-week, regular mobile patrols as well as full-time on-site patrols during periods of higher activity, dedicated to the designated patrol area.</p> <p>STC peacekeepers and Salvation Army security will also patrol the perimeter of their properties and connect with the coordinated public safety members regularly.</p> <p>The safety patrol schedule will be adjusted as needed.</p>
<p><b>Coordinated Communications</b></p> 	<p>Communications will be consistent, transparent and collaborative between all parties:</p> <p>The Saskatoon Tribal Council, Salvation Army, Saskatoon Fire Department, Saskatoon Police Service, the City of Saskatoon, Commissionaires, and Province of Saskatchewan meet weekly to discuss data, activities and problem-solve. Summarized updates will be provided to Riversdale BID and other key organizations or businesses.</p>
<p><b>Coordinated Data and Analysis</b></p> 	<p>Key data is tracked, evaluated and assessed. Commissionaires and STC provide regular reports to the City which are shared with SPS, SFD and the Province and used to determine when and how to adjust the coordinated community safety plan to address emerging concerns.</p>
