



Recognize the **FRIGHT** before they **BITE**.

Most dogs bite out of fear. Do your part and be dog smart.

Everyone can prevent bites from happening – including you! Prevention is key for a safe community.

When most dogs bite they do so out of fear, so it is important to recognize when a dog looks fearful. For most dogs that will look like:

- Wide eyes
- Ears lowered
- Tail tucked
- Avoiding eye contact



What to do if bitten

- ☐ Call Population and Public Health 306-655-4612
- ☐ Contact doctor and discuss:
 - Rabies
 - Tetanus immunization
 - Possible infection
