## **Cemetery Plots**

A variety of options are available for casket or cremation, including upright monument, flat marker and columbarium areas, as well as religious and non-denominational sections.

# **Perpetual Care Fund**

Part of all plot fees go towards the Woodlawn Cemetery's Perpetual Care Fund. This fund ensures that long-term care, maintenance and landscaping are carried out to the highest standards.

*In addition, there is a Monument* Perpetual Care Fund with fees varying with the type and size of the monument. This fund is used for the ongoing care of monuments such as levelling of upright or flat markers.

### Interment Services

*Includes all aspects of preparing the grave* for interment (burial) during regular cemetery hours including excavation, setting up the lowering device and greens, closing the grave after the service and seeding the interment site.
