
We have received your request for a smaller black cart.

Get Ready for Your New Garbage Cart





WHEN WILL I GET MY NEW CART?

Small and medium black carts will be delivered April 15 through June 15. Cart swaps will correspond with your regular scheduled garbage collection day. Some neighbourhoods have more carts being delivered than others and will take up to two collection routes to be completed.

Check the calendar to see when your route is scheduled for cart swaps. Be sure to roll out your cart on your collection date and roll it back in after 6pm.

We are finalizing a detailed delivery calendar and it will be posted online at saskatoon.ca/cartswap once available. Be sure to check back!

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I DON'T ROLL OUT MY CART ON MY SWAP DAY?

If your existing black cart is not out on the day of the swap, a second swap attempt will occur based on vendor availability.

If you don't roll your cart out and miss your swap, you will need to resubmit your request during the fall intake period and you will continue to be charged your existing cart rate.

WHAT IF THEY MISSED MY CART ON MY INTENDED CART SWAP DAY?

Please note there is a high volume of requests and that our timeline for cart swaps may change due to delays or unforeseen circumstances (i.e. weather, road conditions, construction).

WHEN DOES MY NEW UTILITY RATE BASED ON CART SIZE START?

The variable rates based on cart size will show up on your utility bill once cart swaps are completed city-wide on July 1. The rates are approximately as follows: small (120 L) cart - \$3.73, medium (240 L) - \$7.05 and large (360 L) - \$10.58.

Monthly rates are current estimates for 30 days of service. Bag calculation based on a 45L kitchen garbage bag.

CAN I SWAP MY CART AGAIN IN THE FALL?

Households can have one cart swap in 2024. You will be able to swap your cart again in 2025*.



*A cart swap fee may apply to households upsizing their carts in 2025.

What you need to know about your cart swap

- Check saskatoon.ca/cartswap to see when you are scheduled to have your new cart delivered.
- Make sure to roll out your existing cart on each garbage collection day and leave it out until 6PM during the cart swap window.
- Existing carts must be left at their collection location (front street or back lane, depending on your address) to be emptied.
- The smaller cart will not be delivered unless your existing cart is retrieved.
- Once your smaller cart has been delivered, it's yours to use! Return it to where you normally store your cart. Visit saskatoon.ca/cartcare for more information.
