REGISTRATION

 Check-in time is 1 p.m. Check-out time is 11 a.m. If you would like to stay longer, please check with the office to see if a late check-out can be accommodated.

WHILE IN THE PARK

- Quiet time is from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. No visitors are allowed after 11 p.m.
- Security will be on site after office hours. The campground manager is on-call 24/7. For contact information please visit the office.
- The City of Saskatoon and the Campground Manager reserve the right to evict anyone causing any disturbance in the park without refund and will not be responsible for personal property or possessions.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, and rollerblades are permitted within the park by our registered guests. Respect other campers, do not park on walking paths or roadways.
- Children must be supervised in the campground at all times to ensure their safety.
- Pets are welcome, but must be on a leash at all times and they are not to be left unattended. Please clean up after your pet. Complimentary pet scoop bags are available at the office. Barking dogs will not be tolerated.
- Smoking and vaping tobacco is only permitted in the visitor's campsite, camper, tent or vehicle in accordance with Bylaw No. 8286. Smoking or vaping cannabis is prohibited except inside the visitor's camper, tent or vehicle. Smoking or vaping and alcohol are prohibited in campground common areas.

VEHICLES

- Speed limit is 15 kilometres/10 miles per hour.
- · Do not park on roadways.
- Please ensure vehicles are not parked blocking the entrance to adjacent sites or in vacant sites.
- Please refrain from parking and driving on the grass.
- Servicing and repairing vehicles in the campground is prohibited.

BARBECUE USE

- Please do not place live coals from barbecues in garbage bins or dump ashes at your site. Our staff will clean your barbecue.
- · Cutting trees or gathering firewood is prohibited.
- No fires permitted after 11 p.m. Campfires must be in barbecue stands only and kept to a reasonable and safe size.

LAUNDRY & OTHER SERVICES
