## BEFORE YOU CONSUME THE WATER

You may begin using your tap water as normal after you complete the following steps:

1. Run cold water faucets and drinking fountains for at least one minute before using the water.
2. Drain and flush the ice-making system in your refrigerator.
3. Run water softeners through a regeneration cycle.
4. Drain and refill hot water heaters set below 45°C (normal setting is 60°C).
