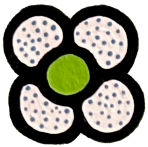


# Red Dress Day May 5, 2025



## All Indigenous Women, Girls & Two Spirit are Sacred



Please join us on Monday, May 5 to recognize Red Dress Day and honour Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls and Two Spirit peoples. As part of this day, we will host a Knowledge Sharing, featuring information booths, focused on raising awareness around safety, domestic violence, human trafficking and its risk factors, and current community supports. We are working towards building capacity within the community to prevent and ultimately eliminate the risk that Indigenous Women, Girls, and Two Spirit+ individuals face in everyday life.

**We invite your organization to host an Information Booth at the Knowledge Sharing at Cosmo Civic Centre from 10am - 3pm.**

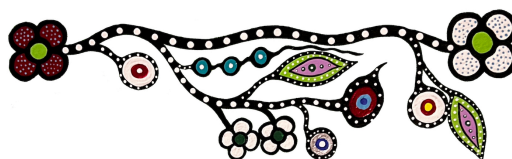
In addition to the information booths, there will be a program from 11am - 12pm, art activities hosted by Remai Modern, and bagged lunches will be available for participants. At 12:30pm community members can attend "Training Active Bystanders" delivered by Mennonite Central Committee, registration required.

After the Knowledge Sharing, we will host the Red Dress Day Walk, followed by dinner and support services for families of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls and Two Spirit peoples. These additional activities are not required of you, but everyone is welcome.

Please note that we are asking organizations to set up their information booths at 9:30am and have attendants at their tables for the entire duration of the Knowledge Sharing (10am to 3pm). There may be opportunities for someone from your organization to speak during the program, and you can indicate your interest on the registration form. The event is open to all ages, and we are focusing our activities for ages 14+. We hope information booths can be interactive, provide key information and takeaway materials, and introduce attendees to organizations and support.
