

Role of ITAG Members

ITAG roles vary according to the needs of the group but generally:

- membership commitment is for 2-year terms;
- members will be offered a \$150 stipend for each meeting they actively participate in;
- members meet at least quarterly, in person, for four-hour durations with the possibility of a yearly day long planning session;
- ITAG has two Group members who act as co-chairs with support provided by City of Saskatoon staff;
- the Group makes decisions only when an Elder is present; and
- members work with City staff to ensure that group work and recommendations are in keeping with the ITAG mission and goals.

Membership Criteria

The Group's membership is made up of Indigenous individuals with representation from distinct and diverse Indigenous peoples. This helps ensure that the Group provides a broad and inclusive perspective reflective of the unique rights and priorities of Indigenous peoples in Saskatoon.

Members of ITAG should:

- be an Indigenous person who resides in Saskatoon;
- understand the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada's (TRC) Calls to Action, United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, and Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, Two Spirit Calls for Justice;
- have substantial experience and knowledge regarding the unique interests, perspectives, and circumstances of Indigenous people of Saskatoon;
- · demonstrate ability to work effectively on a council, group, or board; and
- be knowledgeable in their own Indigenous ways of knowing, traditions, culture, etc.
