BYLAW NO. 9748

The Interpretation Bylaw, 2021

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Interpretation Bylaw, 2021*.

Definitions

2. In this Bylaw and, unless a contrary intention appears, in every City enactment:
 - (a) **“City”** means either the municipal corporation of the City of Saskatoon or the geographical area within the limits of the City of Saskatoon, as the context requires;
 - (b) **“City enactment”** means a bylaw, resolution or policy of the City;
 - (c) **“Council”** means the Council of the City;
 - (d) **“Department”** means an existing department of the City or a former division of the City of the same name, as required by the context;
 - (e) **“Division”** means an existing division of the City or a former department of the City of the same name, as required by the context.

Application

3.
 - (1) This Bylaw applies to every City enactment, whether enacted before or after this Bylaw comes into force, unless a contrary intention appears in this Bylaw or in the City enactment being interpreted.
 - (2) Nothing in this Bylaw excludes the application to a City enactment of a rule of construction applicable to it and not inconsistent with this Bylaw.

References to City Staff Positions

4. If a position to which powers, functions and duties are delegated under a City enactment is altered, modified, renamed, split or consolidated after the City

enactment has come into force, each of those powers, functions and duties are deemed to have transferred, with necessary changes, to the person holding the position most closely connected to that which existed upon the City enactment coming into force.

References to City Enactments

5. (1) A reference in a City enactment to another City enactment is a reference to the other City enactment as amended from time to time or to the City enactment that replaced it.
- (2) Subsection (1) applies whether the other City enactment is amended or replaced before or after the coming into force of the City enactment in which the reference appears.
- (3) A reference in a City enactment to another City enactment that has been repealed and not replaced is a reference to the other City enactment as it read immediately before its repeal.

References to Fees

- 5.1 Fees referenced in City enactments are, unless otherwise stated, exclusive of any applicable taxes.

Coming into Force

6. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.

Read a first time this 22nd day of February, 2021.

Read a second time this 22nd day of February, 2021.

Read a third time and passed this 22nd day of February, 2021.
