- Food-Soiled Paper Products
- Meat and Seafood
- Dairy Products (yogurt, butter, and cheese)
- Solidified Fats and Food Grease
- Baked Goods
- BPI-Certified Compostable Bags

#### **Unbagged Yard waste:**

- Grass clippings
- Leaves

### Why It is Important to Divert Organic Waste from the Garbage

Landfills bury food and yard waste, which leads waste to decompose without oxygen. When this type of waste breaks down in this environment, it turns into leachate (garbage juice) and methane. Leachate pollutes our land and water, and methane is a powerful greenhouse gas that can escape into the atmosphere. Leachate and methane are expensive for landfills to manage. Methane is a much more potent greenhouse gas than carbon dioxide, and leachate needs to be managed under strict environmental regulations.

It is important to responsibly manage food and yard waste, just like we manage recycling and garbage. By diverting food and yard waste, we can reduce our dependence on landfills, minimize the harmful environmental effects of food and yard waste in landfills, and produce useful new resources, such as compost.
