2026 ASSESSMENT NOTICES & THE ASSESSMENT ROLL

Assessment notices are mailed each year in early January.

The City will mail an assessment notice only if there has been a change from the previous year. (Bylaw No. 8067, The Assessment Notices Bylaw, 2002).

January 5 to February 6, 2026: The 2026 Assessment Roll is open for public inspection.

The City's annual Assessment Roll — a listing of all property assessments — is prepared each November.



OTHER IMPORTANT DATES

February 2026 to April 2026: Amended Assessment Notices mailed. Issued to properties where an update to the assessed value is required for a full year.

May 2026: Property Tax notices mailed.

June 30, 2026: Your 2026 Property Tax payment is due.

July 2026 to December 2026: Supplementary Assessment Notices mailed.

Issued to properties where an update to the assessed value is for less than a full year.



🖈 Important Reminder 🖈

To formally appeal your property assessment, you must file your appeal during the 30-Day Assessment Review & Appeal Period, which runs from January 5 to February 6, 2026.

How to Make a Change

- If ownership or property address has changed or is incorrect contact the Assessment Office.
- To change your School Tax Support, fill out the Notice of Appeal and complete the individual School Tax Declaration form at **saskatoon.ca/propertytax**. No fee is required.
- A School Tax Declaration form received after February 6, 2026, the last day of the **30-Day Assessment Review & Appeal period**, will not take effect until 2027.
