

## Where Your Property Tax Dollars Go...

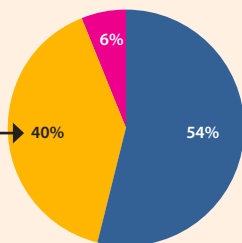

- learn how the municipal portion of your property taxes are allocated to various civic services, many of which we all rely on every day
- review assessment information on nearby properties

Provincial legislation requires the City of Saskatoon to collect Property Taxes on behalf of three taxing authorities:

- City of Saskatoon
- Education
- Library

- 40% of Property Taxes are collected on behalf of the Province for Education (Public and Separate).



- Only slightly more than half of the Property Taxes collected are kept by the City to invest in a wide range of municipal services and programs.
- The remaining tax dollars are collected for the Saskatoon Public Library.

The City's **annual operating budget** determines the dollar amount that will be required from property owners to pay for key civic services like police and fire protection, garbage pick-up or snow and ice management.
