## **Contractor Certification Form**

As a contractor for the City of Saskatoon ("City"), your review and acknowledgement of the requirements outlined in this form and the City of Saskatoon Contractor COVID-19 Emergency Regulations Requirements Contractor Memorandum ("Memorandum") are mandatory prior to working, or continuing to work, for the City. By executing this form, the contractor is verifying that they are in compliance with the requirements set out in this form and the Memorandum (collectively, the "City's contractor vaccine and testing verification process"). It is the contractor's responsibility to communicate these requirements to all of its onsite workers and subcontractors.

The City will ensure that all staff that it provides in connection with the services provided to the City are in compliance with its *Employee Mandatory COVID-19 Proof of Vaccination or Proof of Negative Test Program*.

This form must be executed by a director, officer or other person having the legal authority to contractually bind the contractor.
