

# CITY OF SASKATOON CONTRACTOR COVID-19 EMERGENCY REGULATIONS REQUIREMENTS

## Contractor Certification Form

As a contractor for the City of Saskatoon (“City”), your review and acknowledgement of the requirements outlined in this form and the City of Saskatoon Contractor COVID-19 Emergency Regulations Requirements Contractor Memorandum (“Memorandum”) are mandatory prior to working, or continuing to work, for the City. By executing this form, the contractor is verifying that they are in compliance with the requirements set out in this form and the Memorandum (collectively, the “City’s contractor vaccine and testing verification process”). It is the contractor’s responsibility to communicate these requirements to all of its onsite workers and subcontractors.

The City will ensure that all staff that it provides in connection with the services provided to the City are in compliance with its *Employee Mandatory COVID-19 Proof of Vaccination or Proof of Negative Test Program*.

This form must be executed by a director, officer or other person having the legal authority to contractually bind the contractor.

1. The Company is aware of the City’s contractor vaccine and testing verification process being implemented effective November 15, 2021.
2. The Company is aware, as a service provider to the City, that in order to continue to provide services at any site or property owned or occupied by the City where the services are being performed, all onsite workers and subcontractors of the Company providing such services must be either fully vaccinated or provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test from within the past 7 days prior to accessing the site or property.
3. The Company will not permit any onsite worker or subcontractor who is not compliant with the City’s contractor vaccine and testing verification process access to any site or property where services are being performed for or on behalf of the City.
4. The Company will ensure that all its onsite workers or subcontractors complete a daily COVID-19 health screening tool and comply with all other City worksite COVID-19 protocols.
5. The Company will furnish such evidence or records as may be reasonably requested by the City from time to time to establish its compliance with this certification.
6. The Company confirms that it will be fully compliant with the requirements of this certification on or before November 15, 2021 and will continue to be compliant until notified by the City in writing that compliance is no longer required.
