

Bridging to Tomorrow Update (December 22, 2015)

Traffic Bridge Berm Construction Complete

The berm required to access the river to work on the first phase of the Traffic Bridge is now complete.

About 20,000 cubic metres of stone and clay till was used to construct this berm. If you think of this in terms of mass, that's about 250 blue whales! Stockpiling of berm material was completed on December 21.

Now that crews and equipment have a built up area on which to work, the next phase of construction can begin. Demolition preparation will begin in early January, with demolition of the two southernmost spans. Additional details regarding the demolition will be provided in the coming weeks.
