

Bridging to Tomorrow Update (December 5, 2015)

Open House Feedback

An open house event to share information about the Bridging to Tomorrow Project on December 2, 2015 was attended by over 70 members of the public.

Overall, comments and feedback from the public regarding the project was positive. A total of 13 people filled out comment forms. Topics residents were interested in knowing more about included how the cyclists would use the multi-use pathways on both sides of the Traffic Bridge and where they would connect to, how increased traffic on the bridge would impact the Spadina Crescent round-about, and how the bridge could be used for public events and festivals.

Regarding the North Commuter Parkway, resident's questions and comments were regarding speed on the parkway bridge, how animals would be affected, the potential for noise and light pollution, and where the province is expecting to build its new freeway.
