

Bridging to Tomorrow Update (January 22, 2016)

Traffic Bridge Work to Begin on North Side of River

Traffic Bridge work is starting on the north side of the South Saskatchewan River

Berms

Graham Commuter Partners, the company contracted by the City to undertake the construction of the Bridging to Tomorrow Project, will be constructing a berm that extends from the north bank of the river to the northernmost in-river pier. Once the north berm is in place, GCP will take down the span closest to the north riverbank using explosive charges.
