We are looking at ways to divert and reduce waste, including:



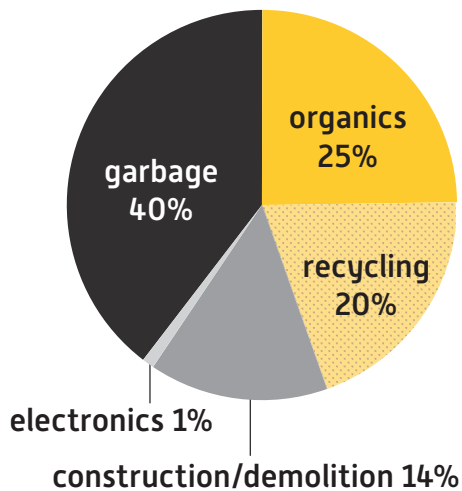
Requirements to divert recyclables and organics

City provided education, enforcement, services, and infrastructure

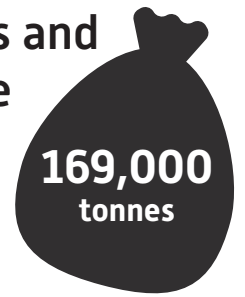
WHAT'S IN OUR TRASH?¹



WHY DO WE NEED THIS?

Saskatoon's businesses and organizations generate **68% of all garbage**

169,000 tonnes of waste go to Saskatoon and area landfills each year.



60% of this waste could be diverted from landfills

The highest diversion opportunities are: organic materials, recyclables, and construction and demolition waste.

Businesses and organizations believe waste is the most important environmental issue

Main concerns include availability of recycling and too much garbage being sent to the landfill.²

Waste from businesses and organizations is managed differently

Private haulers collect waste from most businesses and organizations. Requirements for recycling and organics are unlikely to change who collects waste.
