HEADING TO THE SASKATOON EX? SASKATOON TRANSIT HAS YOU COVERED!

Saskatoon Transit has partnered with the Saskatoon EX to provide free Transit service to Prairieland Park for Superpass holders from July 31 to August 7, 2025. Riders looking to take the bus simply need to show the bus operator their Superpass or wristband when boarding for a free ride.

Older adults (65+) ride free on Thursdays, July 31 and August 7, with or without a Superpass, and Children in Grade 8 and under always ride free.

Skip the parking fees and traffic jams by taking Saskatoon Transit. Transit routes 1 and 19 travel to Prairieland Park. Trips can be planned using real-time apps such as Transit or Google Maps Transit.
