SASKATOON TRANSIT BROADWAY BRIDGE DETOURS START MAY 12

Saskatoon Transit will be detouring several routes starting Monday, May 12, due to the closure of the Broadway Bridge for scheduled rehabilitation.

Bus stops on Broadway Avenue, between 12th and 8th streets, will be temporarily relocated to Victoria Avenue with new short-term signage. Two downtown stops on 19th Street near the Broadway Bridge will also close. Closed bus stops will direct riders to nearby stops for eastbound or westbound travel.

Saskatoon Transit routes to and from downtown will use Victoria Avenue and the Traffic Bridge.

- **Westbound Service:** Routes 8 and the Oskāyak High School Route.
- **Eastbound Service:** Routes 81, 82, 84, 86.
