





Mail-in Ballot Request

You must be an eligible voter to request a mail-in ballot for voting in the 2024 Civic Election
Voter Eligibility criteria as of November 13, 2024:

- You are a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on the day of the election;
- You have resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months;
- You are a resident of Saskatoon, or you have owned assessable land within the City of Saskatoon for at least three consecutive months.

Definitions Related to Assessable Land

(a) Use your highest assessed land if you own more than one property within the municipality; and
(b) If you don't reside in Saskatoon, but own land, the assessed land must be registered in the voter's name, not registered in a company name;
(c) select No School Support in the school Support field.

Click the "School Support" drop-down and select your school division. Residents of Saskatoon must select either Public School or Separate School.

To vote in the Separate school division, you must be of the Catholic faith (any Catholic rite, such as Roman, Ukrainian, Chaldean, etc., that recognizes the pope as the leader of the church.)

Only voters who own assessable property, but do NOT reside in Saskatoon, will select "No School Support".

15 Track your application using the confirmation code. Once accepted, Elections Saskatoon will mail you a ballot kit containing a ballot, envelopes, and an instruction sheet. Mailing will begin in late October.

16 Follow the instructions carefully!

17 Return your ballot by mailing your completed kit back to Elections Saskatoon before 8 p.m. CST on November 13, 2024.
