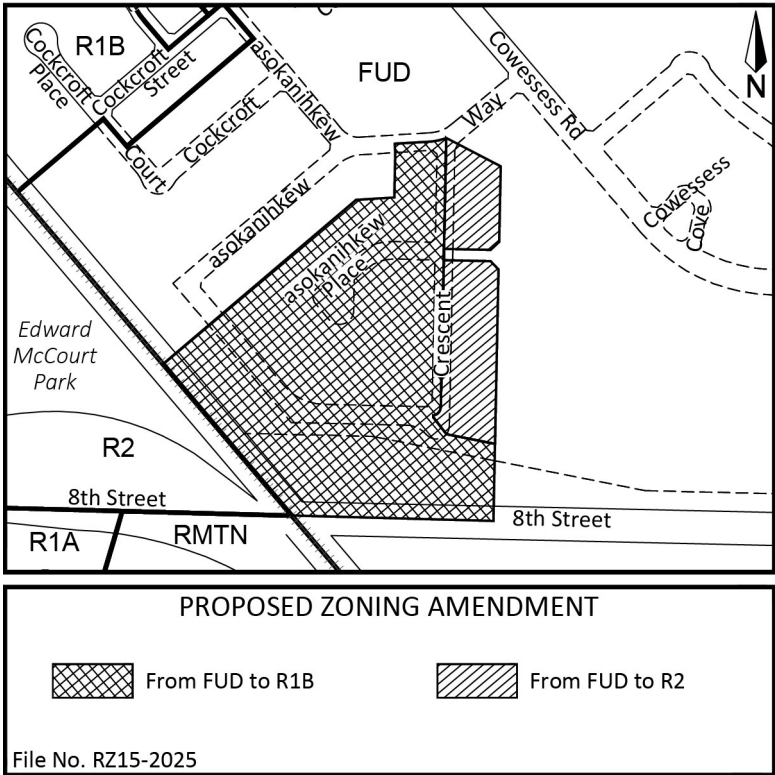


ZONING NOTICE
BRIGHTON NEIGHBOURHOOD
PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 10094, THE ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2025 (NO. 17)

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to the City’s Zoning Bylaw (No. 9990) proposed by Dream Development to rezone land in the Brighton neighbourhood. By way of Bylaw No. 10094, The Zoning Amendment Bylaw, 2025 (No. 17), the subject land near asokanihkēw Crescent and asokanihkēw Place, is proposed to be rezoned from FUD – Future Urban Development District to R1B – Low Density Residential District 1B and R2 – Low Density Residential District 2.

REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT – The proposed rezoning will provide for low density residential development and related community uses in alignment with the approved Brighton Neighbourhood Concept Plan.
