

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS LIBRARY BOARD

The Saskatoon Public Library Board helps connect the citizens of Saskatoon to lifelong learning and engagement opportunities in order to meet present and future challenges. The Board fills a governance role for the municipal library system as outlined in *The Public Libraries Act*; and to ensure that library programs, services and facilities meet the needs of the citizens of Saskatoon.

Consideration for service on this Board includes the following general qualifications and specific skill sets:

- Knowledge of the public library and its services;
- Possession of a valid library card;
- Legal expertise;
- Experience with capital campaigns/fund development;
- Financial expertise;
- Connections with Indigenous community; and,
- Involvement with early childhood literacy.

The Board holds a minimum of six meetings per year, on the third Wednesday of the month at 4:00 p.m. There are no meetings in July and August. There is no remuneration paid to Board members.

Interested applicants are asked to submit an application and resumé with two letters of reference by no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, October 5, 2018**, using the Committee Application Form found online at saskatoon.ca/boards. All applications will be kept on file and reviewed throughout the year should further vacancies occur.
