The Electric Light and Power Exception Bylaw, 2025

The Council of The City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Electric Light and Power Exception Bylaw, 2025*.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to suspend application of the carbon tax charge provisions in Bylaw No. 2685, *A bylaw to regulate the sale of electric light and power in the City of Saskatoon and fixing the rates and deposits therefor*.

Carbon Tax Charge Exception

3. Notwithstanding subsection 6(1) of Bylaw No. 2685, *A bylaw to regulate the sale of electric light and power in the City of Saskatoon and fixing the rates and deposits therefor*, the City shall not include carbon tax charges in the rates payable by customers for the supply of electric current for light and power.

Coming into Force and Expiry

4. (1) This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its final passing.
(2) Unless repealed earlier, this Bylaw expires at the end of the day on December 31, 2026.

Read a first time this 1st day of April, 2025.

Read a second time this 1st day of April, 2025.

Read a third time and passed this 1st day of April, 2025.
