

BYLAW NO. 5713

A bylaw of The City of Saskatoon to regulate and control the dumping of refuse and waste material on property under the ownership or control of The City of Saskatoon.

The Council of The City of Saskatoon enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Anti-Dumping Bylaw".
2. In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (a) "Waste" means any discarded or abandoned organic or inorganic material, including material or by-products discarded in a manufacturing or producing process; snow; ice; dirt; rocks; rubble; garbage; tree cuttings; grass; leaves; empty or partly empty tins, boxes, cartons, bottles and containers; discarded paper and fabrics, discarded household utensils; household furniture; household appliances of any nature; trees; concrete; or any other refuse, rubble, or matter.
 - (b) "City" means the corporation of The City of Saskatoon.
3. No person shall dump or dispose or cause to be dumped or disposed any waste on any property owned by the City, or leased by the City, or under the jurisdiction and control of the City, without first securing written permission from the City Council of The City of Saskatoon so to do. This section does not apply to:
 - (a) areas designated by sign as landfill sites for the disposal of waste;
 - (b) any person removing snow, ice or water from a sidewalk abutting his or her premises and depositing such waste upon any abutting boulevard, lane or street;
 - (c) any person removing leaves, branches, weeds or garden vegetation from his or her residential property and depositing such waste on the boundary of any lane abutting their property.
4. Any person who disposes or dumps waste contrary to this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine on summary conviction of not less than \$100.00, nor more than \$500.00.
5. In addition to the fine levied by the Provincial Magistrate on summary conviction proceedings, the person convicted of a breach of this bylaw shall be responsible for the removal of any waste or rubble dumped or disposed contrary to this bylaw within the time

ordered by the Magistrate under Section 146(6) of The Urban Act of the Province of Saskatchewan.

6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.

Read a third time and passed this 17th day of October A.D. 1977.
