

# BYLAW NO. 8067

## The Assessment Notices Bylaw, 2002

The Council of The City of Saskatoon enacts:

### Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Assessment Notices Bylaw, 2002”.

### Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices, except as provided in this Bylaw.

### Dispensing with Assessment Notices

3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the mailing of assessment notices is dispensed with where the assessed value of any land or improvements:
  - (a) has not changed from the previous year’s assessed value; or
  - (b) has decreased by not more than the lesser of:
    - (i) \$1,000.00 from the previous year’s assessed value; and
    - (ii) 1% of the previous year’s assessed value.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), assessment notices shall be mailed in any year in which assessable properties are revalued under the direction and supervision of the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency.

### Coming into Force

4. This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.

Read a first time this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2001.

Read a second time this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2001.

Read a third time and passed this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2001.
