The Storm Water Management Utility Bylaw, 2001

The Council of The City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Storm Water Management Utility Bylaw, 2001”.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish and regulate the collection, transmission, treatment and disposal of storm water, and to set terms and guidelines for the storm water management utility.

Definitions

3. In this Bylaw,
 - (a) “customer” means a person to whom the waterworks service is supplied under Bylaw No. 7567, The Waterworks Bylaw, 1996; and
 - (b) “storm water” means water that is discharged from a surface as a result of rainfall or snowfall.

Public Utility Service

Storm Water Management Charge

5. (Repealed – Bylaw No. 8987 – December 19, 2011 – Effective January 1, 2012)

Infrastructure Upgrade Charge

- 5.1 Every customer shall pay an infrastructure upgrade charge at the rate set out in Schedule “A”, until December 31, 2018, at which time Section 5.1 expires and is deemed to be repealed.

Accounts

6. Accounts for the storm water management charge shall be added to the monthly water bill of each customer and will be separately shown on the water bill as an additional item.
7. Part VI of Bylaw No. 7567, The Waterworks Bylaw, 1996 shall apply to the storm water management utility and the storm water management charge established hereby.

Coming into Force

8. This Bylaw shall come into force on the first day of January, 2002.

Read a first time this 3rd day of December, 2001.

Read a second time this 3rd day of December, 2001.

Read a third time and passed this 17th day of December, 2001.
