TRANSIT ROUTE CHANGES

Saskatoon Transit is making changes to 3 bus routes as it moves towards providing service closer to the approved Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) lines. Affected routes include: Route 8 inbound/80's outbound (moving onto Broadway), and Routes 1 and 6 which will move off of Broadway Avenue onto 8th Street over Sid Buckwold Bridge. This permanent change will take place as of March 29th, 2020 minimizing delays due to the bridge rehabilitation project while maintaining high frequency.

ELECTION DISCLOSURE COMPLAINTS OFFICER

The City of Saskatoon is seeking applicants to be considered for designation as "Election Disclosure Complaints Officer" to investigate complaints pursuant to Bylaw No. 8491 *The Campaign Disclosure and Spending Limits Bylaw, 2006*.

Duties include:

- Investigate any complaint that a candidate has filed a false, misleading or incomplete disclosure of campaign contributions or expenses.
- Prepare a written decision following the investigation of a complaint
- Submit a report to City council upon completing the investigation of all complaints arising out of a general election or a by-election.

Qualifications include:

- General knowledge of the requirements of *The Campaign Disclosure and Spending Limits Bylaw, 2006*.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Ability to interpret and apply the applicable legislation.
- Ability to work independently.
- Ability to compile complete records of all complaints and all information obtained.
- Ability to maintain a professional approach and maintain an effective working relationship with complainants, candidates and civic officials.
- Applicants must be a Canadian citizen, and be over the age of 18 years.

The term is for two years or until a successor is appointed.
