## PUBLIC NOTICE

### BRIGHTON NEIGHBOURHOOD PROPOSED CONCEPT PLAN AMENDMENT

Saskatoon City Council will consider amendments to the Brighton Neighbourhood Concept Plan submitted by Dream Developments.

The proposed amendments to the Concept Plan consist of minor land use changes and the reconfiguration of streets, linear parks, development sites and service networks located primarily in the western and southern portions of the neighbourhood. The amendment areas are shown on the map below and consist of the following:

#### Amendment Area 1:

- Reconfiguration of streets and development sites; and
- Realignment of the linear parks.

#### Amendment Area 2:

- Reconfiguration of streets and development sites;
- Realignment of the linear parks; and
- Replace three 'Low-Density Group Townhouse Multi-Unit Dwellings' sites with 'Single Unit/Semi-Unit Detached Dwellings' sites.

#### Amendment Area 3:

- Reconfiguration of streets and development sites;
- Realignment of the linear park; and
- Replace a 'Low-Density Group Townhouse Multi-Unit Dwellings' site with 'Single Unit/Semi-Unit Detached Dwellings' sites.

#### Amendment Area 4:

- Reconfiguration of streets.

#### Amendment Area 5:

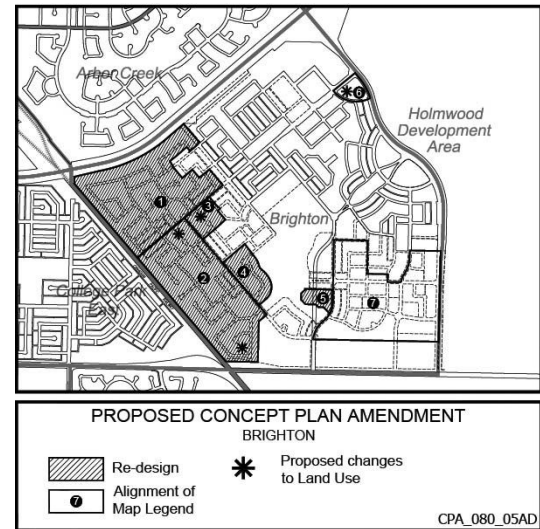
- Reconfigure and increase the area of the 'Low-Density Group Townhouse Multi-Unit Dwellings' site.

#### Amendment Area 6:

- Amend the land use from 'Low Density Group Townhouse Multi-Unit Dwellings' to 'Medium Density Multi-Unit Dwellings'.

#### Amendment Area 7:

- Revise the Concept Plan Land Use Legend from a previous amendment for consistency on mapping for the neighbourhood.



**REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT** – The proposed amendments are intended to update the Concept Plan for future development phases and provides for an increase in the number of park-oriented lots, reduce the length of road right-of-way, increase access points to linear parks, changes to lot orientation, and redistribute the medium density land uses along corridors and nodes within the neighbourhood.
