TRANSIT SERVICE CHANGES

On May 29 Saskatoon Transit will be adjusting three routes.

Route 1 – Exhibition will incorporate part of Route 20, including Brand Road, Melville Street and South Industrial. With this extension of service, regular frequency and service throughout the day will be available to the Auto Mall Village and South Industrial.

Route 20 – S. Industrial will be replaced with the Route 1 extension.

Route 13 - Avalon / Lawson Heights — in July and August, summer construction will impact Route 13 at 12th Street and University Drive. A detour will move Route 13 to 8th Street and Clarence Avenue. Route 13 will continue to service Broadway Avenue south of 8th Street, with additional frequency along Clarence Avenue.
