PUBLIC NOTICE

The Procedures and Committees Bylaw, 2014

City Council will consider a report from the City Clerk at the City Council meeting on Monday, August 30, 2021 at 6:00 p.m., Council Chambers, City Hall, recommending:

- That amendments be made to *The Procedures and Committees Bylaw, 2014* to:
1. permit remote participation in a meeting with 24 hours' notice or less at the City Clerk's discretion;
 2. allow remote attendance at Standing Policy Committees and Public Hearings;
 3. require remote attendees to be visible on video, except as permitted by the Chair or City Clerk;
 4. include remote attendees in quorum; and
 5. restrict meetings from being chaired by a remote attendee, except when the meeting is fully electronic.

The Cities Act, subsection 55.1(4), requires that City Council give Public Notice before amending its *Procedures and Committees Bylaw, 2014*.
