1. PURPOSE

To recover capital costs associated with providing water to outside users beyond the boundaries of the City of Saskatoon.

2. DEFINITION

Outside User - a property owner, town, village, rural municipality or occupants of leased property situated outside the City Boundaries, that is dependent on City water supply.

3. POLICY

Funds required to finance capital costs of the City waterworks system will be obtained from outside users through:

- a) a surcharge added to the City water rate, and
- b) a capital contribution levy.

3.1 Water Rate

The water rate charged to outside users will be the City rate plus a 30% surcharge.

3.2 Capital Contribution Levy

- a) The Minimum Capital Contribution Levy will be based on the prepaid charges levied to property owners in the City for primary or trunk watermains. This minimum levy will be determined by multiplying the average width of a residential lot (i.e. 50 ft) by the Prepaid Servicing Charge for primary watermains.

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- b) The Capital Contribution Levy will be based on increased consumption. The levy will be determined by multiplying the rate per gallon per minute (i.e. the levy in (a) above divided by a 4 gallon per minute average household demand during peak demand) by the anticipated demand as determined by the City.

3.3 Payment

- a) Payment for a capital contribution will be required prior to the actual connection being made or the increased consumption being approved.
- b) The capital contribution will be collected from each applicant for an outside water connection.

4. RESPONSIBILITY

The Waterworks and Pollution Control Department is responsible for administering this policy.
