## 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>

To ensure that purchasers of City-owned land are aware of the existence and location of any easements on such property.

## 2. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

- 2.1 <u>Utility Easement</u> an interest in land granted by the owner which allows a public or private utility (i.e. SaskPower, SaskTel, Utility Services Department Saskatoon Light and Power, Shaw Cable, etc.) to use the land for the purpose set out in the easement.
- 2.2 <u>City-Owned Land</u> includes all land owned or controlled by the City.

## 3. <u>POLICY</u>

All utility easements on City-owned land are subject to approval of the Infrastructure Services Department and must be formally registered with Information Services Corporation (ISC).
