## 1. PURPOSE

To protect parks as recreational areas.

## 2. DEFINITIONS

2.1 Soliciting – includes charitable appeals, petitions, distribution and/or sale of literature or other appeals to the public.

## 3. POLICY

There shall be no soliciting in public parks owned or controlled by the City of Saskatoon unless expressly excepted by Council.

Seasonal Commercial Enterprises that have a permit to operate in Parks are exempted from this policy.

## 4. RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 Director of Recreation and Community Development – is responsible for the administration of this policy.

4.2 General Manager, Community Services – is responsible for the review and update of this policy.

4.3. Standing Policy Committee on Planning, Development and Community Services – is responsible for considering updates to the policy and recommending approval to City Council.

4.4. City Council – is responsible for approving updates to the policy.
