
## NEIGHBOURHOOD CONCEPT PLAN NOTICE STONEBRIDGE NEIGHBOURHOOD CONCEPT PLAN – PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to the Stonebridge Neighbourhood Concept Plan proposed by Meridian Development Corp. The proposed amendments would amend the land use for the eastern portion of 250 Hunter Road from Mixed Use 2 – High Density to Medium Density Residential (65 units/ha±).

**REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT** – The proposed Stonebridge Neighbourhood Concept Plan amendment, in conjunction with a Zoning Bylaw amendment, would provide for the future subdivision and development of the subject parcel in accordance with the development standards of the RM4 – Medium/High Density Multiple-Unit Dwelling District.
