Having considered feedback from two public engagement sessions, the online survey, written submissions and phone calls from residents, the ward boundary changes are:

- Confederation Urban Centre, currently Ward 3, moves to join Ward 2
- Nutana Park, currently Ward 7, moves to join Ward 9
