Proposed Official Community Plan Housekeeping Amendment – Bylaws 9855 & 9856

Saskatoon City Council will consider amendments to The Official Community Plan Bylaw, 2020 (No. 9700) by way of Bylaw No. 9855, The Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw, 2022; and Bylaw No. 9856, The Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw, 2022 (No. 2).

The purpose of the proposed amendments to the Official Community Plan Bylaw, 2020 (OCP) include refinement to Corridor Planning policy, as well as general housekeeping amendments to both narrative and policy throughout the OCP document.

Housekeeping Amendments to the Official Community Plan

The purpose of the proposed amendments are to make minor edits to the OCP to update language and improve user experience. There are no substantive changes being proposed and there will be no changes to the intent of approved direction.

Corridor Planning Policy Amendments to the Official Community Plan

- Edits to location criteria for the Station Mixed Use and Corridor Mixed Use land use
- Edits to allowable height provisions in the Station Mixed Use land use designation.
- Edits to references of Corridor Growth Areas to a singular area to be consistent with the Corridor Transformation Plan. General updates to references to Corridor Planning Policy from "regular transit network"
- to "public transit system" and "network corridors" to "routes."

The proposed changes are not substantive and will not change the policy intent.
