Bylaw No. 9845, The Business Improvement Districts Bylaw, 2022

Saskatoon City Council will consider Bylaw No. 9845, The Business Improvement Districts Bylaw, 2022 at its meeting to be held on Monday, October 31, 2022 at 6:00 p.m., Council Chambers, City Hall.

The purpose of this Bylaw is to repeal Bylaw No. 9235, The 33rd Street Business Improvement District Bylaw, 2014, Bylaw No. 6731, The Broadway Business Improvement District Bylaw, 1986, Bylaw No. 6710, The Downtown Business Improvement District Bylaw, 1986, Bylaw No. 7092, The Riversdale Business Improvement District Bylaw and Bylaw No. 7891, The Sutherland Business Improvement District Bylaw, 1999 and replace them with a bylaw that provides for a governance regime that is consistent, comprehensive and applicable to all business improvement districts. This Bylaw continues the existing business improvement districts and consolidates the governance rules into a single comprehensive document.
